## The latest from the QLD Mines Inspectorate

VERIFICATION OF TRAINING RECORDS AND COMPETENCIES

The mining inspectorate have been made aware of a number of occasions where the validity of coal mine workers training record documents have been questioned

It is recommended that all SSE's review their Safety and Health Management System to ensure that the following matters are compliant in their training systems:


- A documented process is in place for the management of training records.
- That process requires that training records that are accepted as a true record of the competency of a mine worker who has presented these records from a previous employer, has to have verification from the previous mine to validate these records.
- The provision of training records to a mine worker who has requested these for a future employer, requires that these records be verified and validated as a true record of the competency of a mine worker by the current mine.
- In the case of a mine worker who has presented training records that are not verified as a true record of the competency of a mine worker, there is a process for ensuring these records are not accepted.

The presentation of amended or false training records may result in criminal charges.
